This is a case of medical negligence by a grand father that his grand son was not properly treated.

Respondent doctor and the petitioner are present. The doctor explained the grievousness of the burn injury sustained by the boy in the burning fire and the attempt made by the doctor and his staff.

After seven days when the father of the boy reached from abroad he was appraised of the gravity of the situation, the boy was removed to Medical Centre Hospital, Cochin.

According to the petitioner if the facilities available in the Cochin hospital was available in the respondent hospital, his child would have got better treatment and thereby escaped from loss of life.

The doctor also explained the trauma that he had underwent by facing various authorities on the basis of the complaint by the petitioner.

It is an admitted fact that the facilities available in a super speciality hospital cannot be provided by an ordinary nursing home.

The range of expenses also may be different. Even the petitioner has thought of shifting the child to Super Speciality Hospital at Cochin only after the arrival of the father from abroad.

The petitioner also submitted that he does not want to proceed with the enquiry and made a request that people of Thrissur must get the facilities of the Super Speciality Hospital to meet this type of situation.

The District Medical Officer, Thrissur can take initiative in this matter. With this observation this petition is closed.
